#### **Introduction**




How important is the following variable for you decision to save the historic building: "EHB in the centre of the city"





















## Conclusions

The presented Questionnaire is a result of the first focused Workshop of IRC-HERMeS Interreg Balkan Project on conservation planning with experts in the fields of Cultural Heritage (CH) and Information Technology (IT). The Workshop started with an introduction to the Project by the Leader Partner, Cyprus University of Technology, its objectives and main outcomes. It continued with presentations varying from Digital Heritage for Education and the role of Information design in CH to case studies on conservation planning and management.

After the presentations session, the participants gathered all together to a hands-on workshop for the design of a conservation plan. Before answering the questionnaire, they dialogued and exchanged ideas on the current state of conservation planning in their own countries and cities. The questionnaire, managed by the organizers, was flexible and adaptable to host new questions, especially at the *Rating the variables* section, that emerged from the conversation. Through a smart device, they were able to access the online questionnaire in order to place their opinion in a set of questions related to *Which endangered historic building would you save first?*, depending on a number of variables, in which they had all agreed on. Since the sample is a little bit small, the questionnaire will be also distributed to a bigger sample of experts, so the Project can have a more integrated view of the dominating variables.
